Item Number 1: Action Taken Report

Commencement of Online M. Tech Program in CSE

Chairman briefed about the progress of commencement of Online M. Tech programme in CSE to the members. Approval from the Chairman, BoG, has been obtained. Advertisement has been published in national level newspapers and Institute website. The last date for submitting application is May 14, 2021.

Item Number 2: Changes in Ph.D Regulations

The proposed changes in Ph.D. regulations in **Annexure A** are presented by the Ph.D. faculty coordinator Dr. Oishila Bandyopadhyay. The changes have been accepted by the Senate. The modified regulations will be applicable from the coming academic session, that is, July 2021.

Item Number 3: Cancellation of Ph.D Enrolment of 3 Candidates

The Ph.D. faculty coordinator Dr. Oishila Bandyopadhyay presented the status of 4 Ph.D. candidates and briefed the recommendations of DSC to cancel their enrolment. Senate suggested and advised that as UGC has extended the time limit twice by six months and one year, the candidates be given one more chance to continue. This one time extension could be communicated to the candidates, through registered post as a final notice.

Item Number 5: Approval of ECE Course Structure
