De-registration Rules for IIIT Kalyani

The student can be de-registered in a subject during a semester by the concerned faculty member on the ground of poor attendance.

- i) If a student **does not have a minimum of 75% attendance in a subject** (at-least 50% by mid-semester and overall 75% by end-semester), he/she can be de-registered from the subject at the discretion of the subject teacher.
- ii) Only one-time de-registration is permissible and no revocation of the deregistered subject is admissible, except on genuine medical grounds.
- iii) Email warning will be given to the students by the subject teacher prior to de-registration.
- iv) The de-registration process shall commence after the Mid-semester Examination. The de-registration will stop two weeks before the commencement of the End Semester Examination The final list of de-registered students for each subject will be published before distribution of Examination Form.
